Counts towards Niagara County Open Show year End Championships – including shows in May, June, August & September

- Current Rabies Certificate and Negative Coggins Test Required (within 2 calendar years)
- US Equestrian Federation (USEF) Rules apply in all classes.
- Proper Attire Required
- Judges decision is FINAL!
- Youth and Walk/Trot Riders - Age 16 or Under as of Jan. 1.
- Entries in Walk-Trot May Not Enter any other riding class-- Minimum age 6 yr.
- Entries in Walk/Trot/Canter MAY NOT Enter any other riding classes.—Minimum Age 6 Yr.
- Walk/Trot/Canter classes are for **Riders** who are in their 1st or 2nd year of cantering
- **Weather Permitting, Walk-Trot game classes will be run in a separate ring from the W/T/C and Youth/Open game classes.
- ***All Trail classes to be held in a separate area from main ring and to be completed between the hours of 12 Noon and 2PM while the rest of the show is going on.
- Trail and Showmanship classes do not count toward championship awards.
- Command classes are in the Western Pleasure Division and require pleasure type tack.

Show management reserves the right to excuse any unruly horses or horses that may be a hazard to exhibitors or spectators.

RIDE AT YOUR OWN RISK

WNYQHCI is not responsible for accidents or loss to horses, rider, personal property or spectators.

ALL RIDERS MUST WEAR AN ASTM/SEI APPROVED PROTECTIVE HELMET AT ALL TIMES WHILE MOUNTED ON A HORSE ON THE 4-H GROUNDS AND IN ALL CLASSES IN THE RING. HELMETS MAY BE INSPECTED AT ANY TIME.
