- d. Royal Horse Show

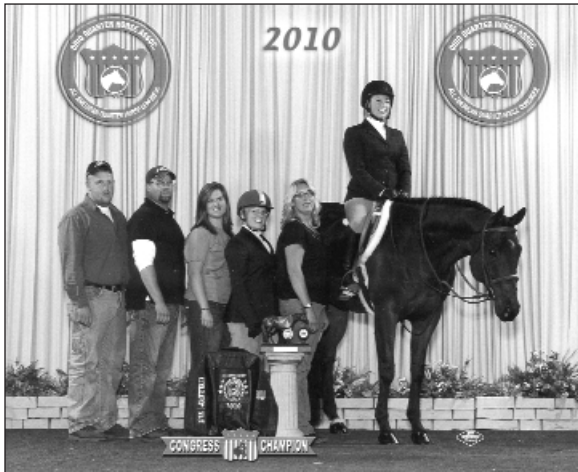
8. Meeting dismissed at 7:29 p.m.

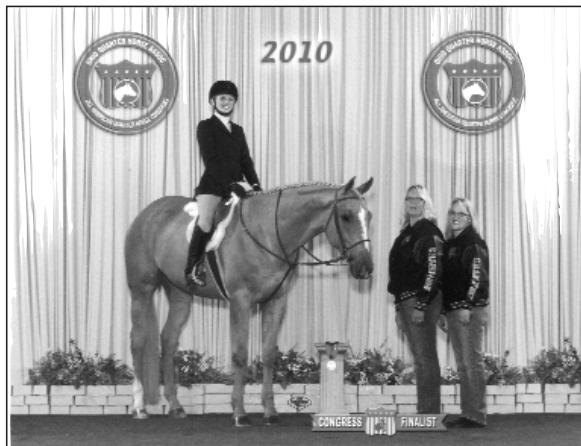
