~~ YOUTH CLUB OPEN HORSE SHOW AWARD ~~

Any Youth Club member interested in qualifying for the Open Horse Show Award should complete this form and return it to the Youth Club Advisor. All rules for participation in this award include rules set in club By-Laws for open show award program.

In order to qualify to receive the Youth Club Open Horse Show Award, each Youth **must**:

1. Have a family membership and indicate the member is to be included in the Youth Club.
2. Participate in fundraisers by participating in at least two (2) fundraisers (product sales, raffle sales, etc.)
3. Attend four monthly **Youth Club meetings** between January 1, 2009 and October 30, 2009.
4. Compete in the qualifying open horse shows with a registered Quarter Horse and earn points to qualify.
5. Have parent sign and OK the set plans for the horse show.

Paperwork **must** be turned in **before** points begin to count.

Awards will be presented to: Top two Youth from each Junior/Youth and Walk-Trot division; cannot cross divisions and can only qualify in one division.

***Points will be awarded for junior or youth and walk-trot classes only with the exception of halter. If no youth class is available, open halter will apply.

A member is limited to one award. In the event a member earns the highest points in more than one division, the award will be given for the division with the highest number of points.
