General Information

One Fee Package Deal — \$200 per horse
Includes Stall (for Friday, Saturday and Sunday nights), Unlimited Class Entries, all Drug Fees, and Office Charges. You MUST SHOW IN A HALTER CLASS TO GET THIS DEAL. The fee must be prepaid by July 15, 2011.

Stalls — \$80 (without package deal)
Price includes Friday, Saturday, Sunday nights, prepaid.
Additional nights prior to Friday night are \$25/night by pre-arrangement with Charlotte Jaynes at 607-546-7373.

Locking Tack Rooms

Locking tack rooms are available in certain barns, limited quantity; must be pre-reserved. \$50

Camper Hookups

Camper Hookups — \$80
Price includes Friday, Saturday, Sunday nights, prepaid.
Additional nights prior to Friday night are \$25/night by pre-arrangement with Charlotte Jaynes only.

Electric and water are available in most spots, but no sewer. You must pre-pay your Camper Fee in order to be insured a spot. Parking is at the direction of the camper lot manager who will be working off of a prepaid list. Campers or trailers parked in camper lot without a visible Camper Permit will be towed. Tow vehicles must be removed and parked in designated area.

Arrival

Horses, Trailers and Campers may not arrive prior to 8:00 am on Friday unless special arrangements are made. If you wish to bring your horses or camper in prior to Friday, you must make reservations with Charlotte Jaynes and obtain a Camper Permit and/or stall

assignment. Campers parked in camper lot without a Camper Permit will be towed.

Horse Trailers

A lot will be provided for parking of dropped horse trailers, but no camping is allowed in that lot.

Refunds

No refunds on stalls, camper or tack room payments except with veterinary certificate.

Rules

U.S. Dollars. All prices on this form and all paybacks are in U.S. dollars.

Entry Fees. Sweepstakes class entry fees must be paid at least one (1) hour before the class.

Registration Requirements. All futurity and sweepstakes classes are open to horses registered with AQHA, APHA, ApHC, and PHBA.

AQHA and NSBA rules apply.

Ownership Requirements. WNYQHCI: All Owners must hold current membership in the Western New York Quarter Horse Club or pay a Non-Member Fee. If a horse has multiple owners, each owner must be a WNYQHCI member or pay a single Non-Member Fee of \$25. WNYQHCI membership fees are \$25 Individual and \$30 Family. NSBA: For NSBA classes, both Owner and Exhibitor must be members of NSBA. If you do not wish to be an NSBA member, you may purchase an NSBA Show Pass (required for both Owner and Exhibitor).

Go-Rounds: All classes consist of one go-round with 2 judges on the date indicated in the show schedule.

Purse Money & Payback Rules: The Purse is comprised of the Added Money plus 80% of all Entry Fees. 100% of the added money will be paid if there are more than 10 horses entered. 50% of the added money will be paid if there are 5-9 horses entered. No added money will be paid if there are less than 5 horses entered. Payback checks will be mailed after the show, provided that all checks for entry payments, stalls & campers have cleared the bank. Any money owed to WNYQHCI for any reason will be deducted from the purse money paid out. \$50 will be charged for NSF checks. Payback percentages (subject to rule on number of entries above) are: 1 entry—100%; 2 entries—60%, 40%; 3 entries—45%, 35%, 20%; 4 entries—40%, 30%, 20%, 10%; 5 entries—34%, 27%, 20%, 10%, 9%; 6 or more entries—32%, 22%, 19%, 10%, 9%, 8%.

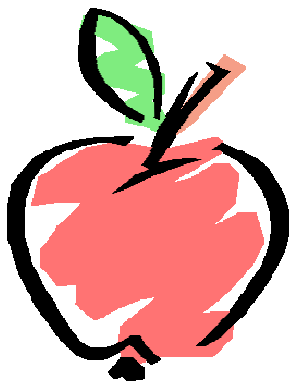
Ties: A tie-breaker judge will break all ties. The judge whose last name is first in the alphabet will be the tie-breaker judge.

Miscellaneous: There will be no refunds given except with vet certificate. Entries will be accepted at the show up to one hour before the class. Office fees associated with the Candy Apple Classic will apply to sweepstakes entries. You must see the show office to receive your number and pay your office fee.
